


# PUP SAVER

## HOT PAWS



**5 SECOND TEST:** IF YOU CAN'T EXPOSE THE BACK OF YOUR HAND TO THE SURFACE FOR 5 SECONDS, DON'T MAKE YOUR DOG WALK ON IT.

77° Outside = Asphalt is 125°

86° Outside = Asphalt is 135°

99° Outside = Asphalt is 160°

## DOGS DON'T SWEAT

Dogs cool themselves by **PANTING**, laying on a cool surface (**conduction**), or being exposed to cool air or water (**convection**).

**CONDUCTION & CONVECTION ARE NOT POSSIBLE IN A HOT CAR OR WHEN EXERCISING IN HOT TEMPERATURES.**

Heat Stroke Begins

## Heat Stroke Kills

### EARLY SIGNS

Heavy Panting  
Rapid Breathing  
Excessive Drool  
Bright Red Tongue

### ADVANCED

Lethargy  
Vomiting/Diarrhea  
Raspy Loud Breath  
White/Blue Gums  
Seizures/Coma

### TREATMENT

Small drinks of H2O  
Hose down  
Cold pack to groin  
Contact Vet
