

Dogs cool themselves by PANTING, laying on a cool surface (conduction), or being exposed to cool air or water (convection).

CONDUCTION & CONVECTION ARE NOT POSSIBLE IN A HOT CAR OR WHEN EXERCISING IN HOT TEMPERATURES.
